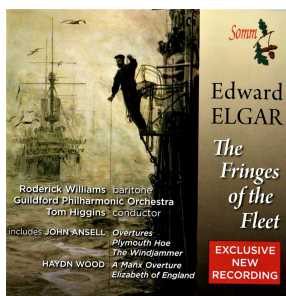


**Elgar as we knew him - a second slice**

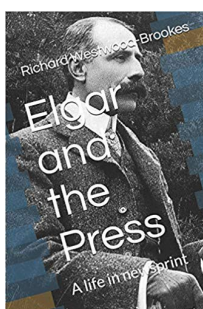
